3. **The Context:**

Earlier we had intercollegiate debate competition. Last year IQAC has decided to start elocution competition which is named after the founder president Late RajabhouKadam.

4. **The Practice:**

On the occasion of the silver jubilee celebration of the establishment of college, the IQAC decided to begin a state level elocution competition each year in the month of January. The topic of the event is decided in the IQAC meeting. A committee is formed to organize the event. The circular having all details about the event are circulated through social media. The prizes are attractive so that the students from faraway places will be able to participate in the event. The first prize is of Rs 5000/-, second of Rs. 3500/- and third of Rs 2500/-. The participants coming from faraway places, being provided with accommodation and lunch. All these prizes are being sponsored by the faculty members. Each year new faculty initiates to sponsor the prize. Before the event many students prepare themselves for the event. They are scrutinized and only two students from each unit are allowed to participate in the final event.



5. Evidence of the Success:

This event has created positive atmosphere among the student community. Students of this college are preparing themselves for the various competitions held at intercollegiate level. The first competition took place on 17th January 2019 wherein 17 students participated from all over Maharashtra. The practice has helped college to gain fame and name in the region.
